Photography Contest
PROSPECTUS**

1. Photos must be taken in Antrim, Benzie, Grand Traverse, Kalkaska, or Leelanau counties in Michigan.
2. Photos may be horizontal or vertical orientation.
3. Photos must depict the outdoors, such as water scenes, wildlife or landscapes and accurately reflect the subject matter as it appeared in the viewfinder. Photos can be of any season. Images that are extensively manipulated in photo editing software will be disqualified.
4. Photos should be jpgs, 300 dpi. Hard copy photos will be disqualified.
5. The file name of each photo should be its official artistic title followed by the location where the photo was taken, for example, "West Bay Sunset-Omena."
6. You may submit up to 5 photos.
7. Photos must be emailed to art@gtbay.org by 11:59 pm, Wednesday, November 15, 2017. E-mail photos separately if the file size of each is 10 MB or larger.
8. Entry fee is \$10. Payment must be received online or postmarked by November 15, 2017. You can pay online at <http://www.gtbay.org/ways-to-give/donate-now/> or mail a check payable to The Watershed Center to: The Watershed Center, 13272 S. West Bay Shore Drive, Traverse City, MI 49684. Your entry fee supports The Watershed Center's mission to protect and preserve Grand Traverse Bay and its 1,000-square-mile watershed.
9. The top 12 photos will appear in Bay Life North Magazine's January/February 2018 issue. (A photographer may have more than one photo appear in the magazine.) Photos will also be displayed on The Watershed Center photo contest web page and on social media as part of our "Watershed Wednesday" series.
10. Prizes will be awarded for first, second, and third places. Prizes will be awarded to separate photographers.
11. The Watershed Center retains the right to use any photo submitted for print or electronic public education or advertising mediums, including but not limited to web site, Facebook, Twitter, e-news, advertisements, brochures, and PowerPoint presentations. Credit and/or the copyright symbol and photographer's name will appear when possible. By entering the contest, you agree to these terms.
